

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Our learning super power this term is persevering so we will be encouraging the children to keep trying even when things are tricky. In PSHE we'll be sharing some stories to help us think about looking after planet and we'll be joining in Hedgehog Awareness Week. We'll also be thinking about healthy foods and ways that we can keep our bodies healthy through good choices over diet and exercise.

Physical Development

This term we'll be practising our ball skills with a range of different minibeast themed challenges. Each class will also be having some ball skills sessions with Coach Danny.

We'll also be continuing to develop our fine motor skills in our indoor and outdoor fine motor areas through fun activities such as worm and caterpillar threading,

Communication and Language

This term we will be expanding our vocabulary through books and stories including Jack and the Beanstalk, the Very Hungry Caterpillar and the Giant Jam Sandwich. We'll also be re-telling familiar stories using puppets and props and we'll be introducing some new books into our reading areas. We'll also be doing lots of talk for writing and forming our ideas into complete sentences.

Creative Development

This term we will be learning about the artist Jim Dine and using colour mixing skills and different media to create art inspired by his work. We'll also be re-visiting junk modelling skills and learning how to create moving parts by using sliders, levers and split pins.

The children will also be joining in with creative challenges themed around different mini beasts.

Our Summer Learning Journey: In the Garden

Mathematics

In our number work we'll be looking at doubling and sharing, number bonds and how to use our understanding of number to know addition and subtraction facts within 5. We'll also be learning how to share amounts into equal groups and how to use part-whole models to solve missing number problems.

Literacy Development

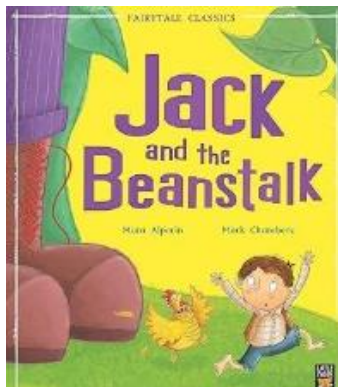
In literacy we will be focusing on our writing skills and using interesting pictures, objects and books to inspire our sentences. We will also be practising forming our letters correctly and segmenting to spell longer words phonetically. We'll also be developing our fluency to read words with 2 letter sounds and show an understanding of what we've read and written by checking it makes sense.

Knowledge of the World

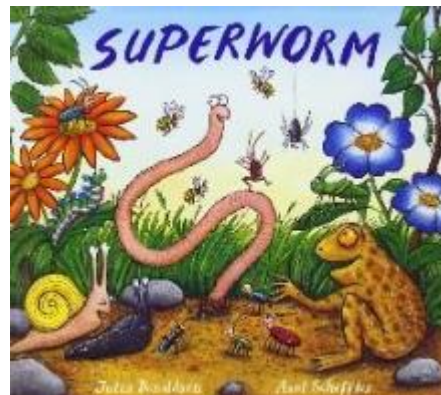

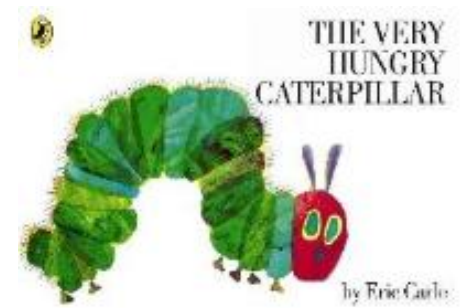

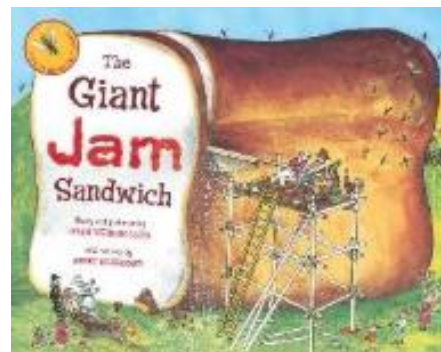
